The Challenge

The challenge with growing out young stud rams is to ensure that growths rates are maximised on a steady plane of nutrition, whilst avoiding setbacks such as urolithiasis and acidosis.

As well, stud breeders need to ensure that the true genetic potential of the wool is expressed by sale time and that the rumen is functioning at maximum efficiency in order to make the most of paddock and expensive shed feeds.

In the case of commercial breeders, Rams must be in prime condition prior to joining to ensure maximum conception rates as well as a tight lambing window.

The Results

The Rate

The intake of any loose lick depends on many factors including nutritional status and body condition of stock, feed quality and weather conditions. On average, expect sheep to consume 30 – 50gms/head/day.

It is important that all stock in the mob have access to the product. When using small lick feeders, Fabstock recommend 1 per /50 sheep.

To ensure Rams are 'prepared for joining', they need to be 'prepared' 8 weeks prior to being introduced to the ewes. This will ensure an abundant supply of fresh viable sperm.

It is important that feeders are not allowed to run out of lick, as this tends to encourage overconsumption.
